#### BACK TO SCHOOL HEALTH MEASURES

All the health and organizational measures taken by the establishment are detailed in the Vademecum and the Addendum which have been sent to you.

**We would like to thank the parents in advance for their help, which will be essential to the safety and smooth flow of student entry and exit. We are grateful to you for scrupulously respecting the following points from the start of the school year:**

1. Scrupulously respect the drop-off and collection times for children at the gates
2. Line up at the Rond-Point in the order of arrival of families, and with due regard for social distancing (marking on the ground) while waiting to drop off / collect their child at the gate.
3. Do not stay on the Rond-Point after dropping off or collecting your child.

Given the health rules imposed on us (minimizing contact; maintaining social distances; respecting barrier gestures), we will unfortunately not be able to accommodate all parents this year in the schoolyard. **Only parents of PS and MS, as well as parents of other levels whose child is entering school for the first time, can accompany the child to the teacher.** They will need to:

- Not be bound subject to quarantine measures
- Certify on honor that they do not have symptoms of Covid-19 infection
- Wear a mask
- Wash your hands when entering s
